

Training and Livery -Terms and Conditions

- ❖ The owner will be responsible for the following costs:
 - Livery
 - Training
 - Wormers and inoculations
 - Farrier
 - Dental care
 - Veterinary costs
 - Insurance
 - Tack replacement and repair (including rugs and other equipment)
- ❖ The owner shall be responsible for delivery and collection of the horse to the livery yard. Extra days or part days will be charged at full livery rate.
- ❖ On delivery of the horse the owner shall deliver to the trainer the horse's passport, vaccination certificate, and importation papers (where applicable) duly stamped in the UK.
- ❖ The owner will warrant the animal is healthy, sound and free from contagious diseases and will be responsible for any costs involved should disease be brought into the yard.
- ❖ The owner is obliged to inform the trainer of any dangerous behaviour the horse may have which could affect the safety of the trainer and other staff. It is the trainer's prerogative to refuse to train any horse deemed dangerous by the trainer.
- ❖ In the event of non-payment of costs by the owner the trainer has a lien on the horse pending the payment of all outstanding debts and claims.
- ❖ The owner will provide tack and stable clothing with the horse and be responsible for its repair and replacement by arrangement with the trainer.
- ❖ The owner may visit the horse at any time convenient to the livery yard where the horse is kept.
- ❖ The owner places the horse in the care of the trainer at the full risk of the owner. The trainer shall not be liable for any accident, illness or injury which the horse may incur.
- ❖ The horse will only be ridden by Mrs Lilley or an equivalently trained rider under Mrs Lilley's supervision. (Should Mrs Lilley be injured, for example, and unable to ride)
- ❖ The trainer will exercise due care for the welfare and well-being of the horse at all times.
- ❖ If requested, the trainer will provide a written report detailing the condition of the animal, its training progress, and details of future training plans.
